8. Does "reaching 6% by 2022" CEO mentioned in the briefing refer to the revenue growth target?

9. What is the company's view on the overall gaming market in 2022 and the long-term market growth in the next 3-5 years? What is the company's strategy to maintain outperforming the market growth?

10. In the conference call last year, CEO mentioned that the channel inventory level is 30% lower than its normal level. What is the current status of the channel inventory level?

11. What is the impact to gross profit as we see the increase in material cost, logistic cost and the inflation issue? Will the company pass the cost increase to customers?
